## ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING + RAFFLE

Thursday 2nd December at 7.30pm in the Community Centre

You will have already received notice of our AGM. Please make sure that a representative from your household comes to this important meeting which will be attended by council officers and the recently enlivened committee. As it is Christmas time we are having **drinks and mince pies** before hand (from 7pm) and everyone attending will get a **free** ticket for our **Christmas Raffle** with some great seasonal prizes. ## MAJOR WORKS

We have agreed with the Council that Major Works will continue and not be on hold until we have finished our exploration of self-management. Based on the aborted scheme we are currently drawing up a list of what we believe should be in Major Works. It is our intention that you will have a chance to comment before we sit down with the Council to see what can and cannot be included under Council rules. This way, we shall all have a chance to state what we would like to see included well before the Council goes out to tender.

In negotiation with the Council we shall be able to establish a number of costing models which we can then agree on after discussion. There will then be the usual and legally required consultation process before the Council finalises the Major Works programme.
